## **Posted: July 13, 2023**

- 1. The opportunity says there is a matching requirement, but don't see how much. Can you please clarify. The match requirement is 25%. Details about the match requirement can be found on page 14 of the NOFO.
- 2. The opportunity talks about a "partnership", is it that mandatory we set up an MOU prior to applying? It is encouraged but not required to have the MOU in place before applying.
- 3. Can you please clarify if this grant is for "in-house" jail residential treatment or can we utilize the grant to pay to place detainees/participants in the program that is an outside inpatient treatment center. The grant is for "in-house" treatment of incarcerated participants.
- 4. Can you use the grant to pay for medically assisted treatment (MAT) for detainees in jail? Yes, RSAT funding can be used to support MAT programs.
- 5. On Page 17, the NOFO lists unallowable costs and includes:
- "Implementation of a new program involving the use of chemicals"
- Can you please define what is meant by "chemicals"? This refers to EPA chemicals, such as those that might affect groundwater, etc.
- 6. Can a stand-alone not-for-profit apply or just state and local governments? No, this grant is for Illinois local government and state agencies.
