# **RSAT Grant Program**

### Purpose of RSAT

The Residential Substance Abuse Treatment (RSAT) Program funding is federally administered by the Office of Justice Programs for the purpose of:

- developing and implementing residential substance abuse treatment programs within State correctional facilities, as well as within local correctional and detention facilities in which inmates are incarcerated for a period of time sufficient to permit substance abuse treatment;
- encouraging the establishment and maintenance of drug-free prisons and jails;
- developing and implementing specialized residential substance abuse treatment programs that identify and provide appropriate treatment to inmates with co-occurring mental health and substance abuse disorders or challenges.







# Program Design

This grant will fund programs in the following categories:

- I. Corrections-based substance use disorder treatment
- II. Jail-based substance use disorder treatment
- III. Aftercare services







## **Program Requirements**

RSAT funds may be used to implement three types of programs in which jail detainees, incarcerated individuals, and those returning to society may voluntarily participate: corrections (prison-based) programs, jail-based programs, and aftercare services. Applications involving partnerships with community-based substance use disorder treatment programs are highly encouraged. Program design must be based on effective, scientific practices.







## **Eligible Applicants**

This solicitation is open to Illinois local government and state agencies with demonstrated experience in providing substance abuse treatment programming for individuals in the criminal justice system pre-and post-release. This includes corrections-based substance use disorder treatment and jail-based substance use disorder treatment.







## Goals, Objectives, & Performance Metrics

The goals of the RSAT Program are to:

- provide residential substance use disorder treatment for incarcerated individuals,
- prepare individuals for their reintegration into the communities
- assist individuals and their communities through the reentry process.
- provide Performance Measures Reporting
- submit quarterly progress and financial reports







# **Funding Information**

- period of performance of October 1, 2023, to September 30, 2024
- not to exceed 36 months
- a total of \$760,000 in funding is available through this solicitation.
   Applicants may request a minimum of \$75,000 and a maximum of \$200,000 in grant funding.
- A minimum of \$75,000 must be reserved for local government agencies




# Personcentered Language






