

## How to Apply for Funding via AmpliFund Grant Management System

The Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority (ICJIA) reminds all potential applicants start with the Grant Accountability and Transparency Act (GATA) Grantee Portal registration and strongly encourages entities to verify their System for Award Management (SAM) registration is up to date as soon as possible. This will allow the time necessary to process entity validations within the GATA Grantee Portal. If you're already registered with SAM, and have a Unique Entity ID, entities must renew their registration every 365 days to keep it active.

### NEW ICJIA FUNDING APPLICATION PROCESS

Grant applications must be submitted via **AmpliFund Grant Management System**. Applications will no longer be accepted via email.
